

EEA GRANTS 2014-2021

Portugal was the sixth beneficiary country, out of a total of fifteen, to sign the Memorandum of Understanding, initiating the implementation of the Financial Mechanism that **extends until 2024.**

For the period 2014-2021, a total contribution of \in 2.8 billion was agreed for 15 beneficiary states.

Portugal will benefit from a global allocation of € 102.7 million.



Natural persons are not eligible




