Treasury finances. January-June 2003

Data on the transactions of the Treasury for the first half of this year are now at hand. They are on a cash basis and therefore not comparable to the Treasury accounts or the fiscal budget. both of which are on an accrual basis.

Treasury revenue increases by 17 billion krónur from the previous year and expenditure by 7 billion. The revenue side is most influenced by an 11 billion increase in revenue from asset sales. in addition to the impact of increased economic activity on revenue in spite of considerable reductions in income and net wealth taxes on individuals and businesses in 2002 and 2003. The expenditure side is most influenced by rising outlays for health. social security and education. whereas the interest cost of the Treasury is declining. These trends tend to confirm the Ministry's macro-economic forecast of last April where is was predicted that the recent recession was almost over and would be replaced by increasing growth.

The revenue balance showed a surplus of 2.9 billion krónur compared with a deficit of 7.7 billion a year ago. Cash from operations. however. was in deficit by 9.2 billion compared with a deficit of 7.7 billion a year ago. The financial surplus amounted to 17.6 billion. an increase of 14.2 billion over a year ago. the improvement being wholly attributable to sales of the Treasury's shares in the two commercial banks. Landsbanki and Bunadarbanki as well as in the construction firm. Iceland Prime Contractors. These sales have resulted in a net financial surplus of 8.4 billion in the first half of this year compared with a deficit of 4.3 billion at the same time last year.
